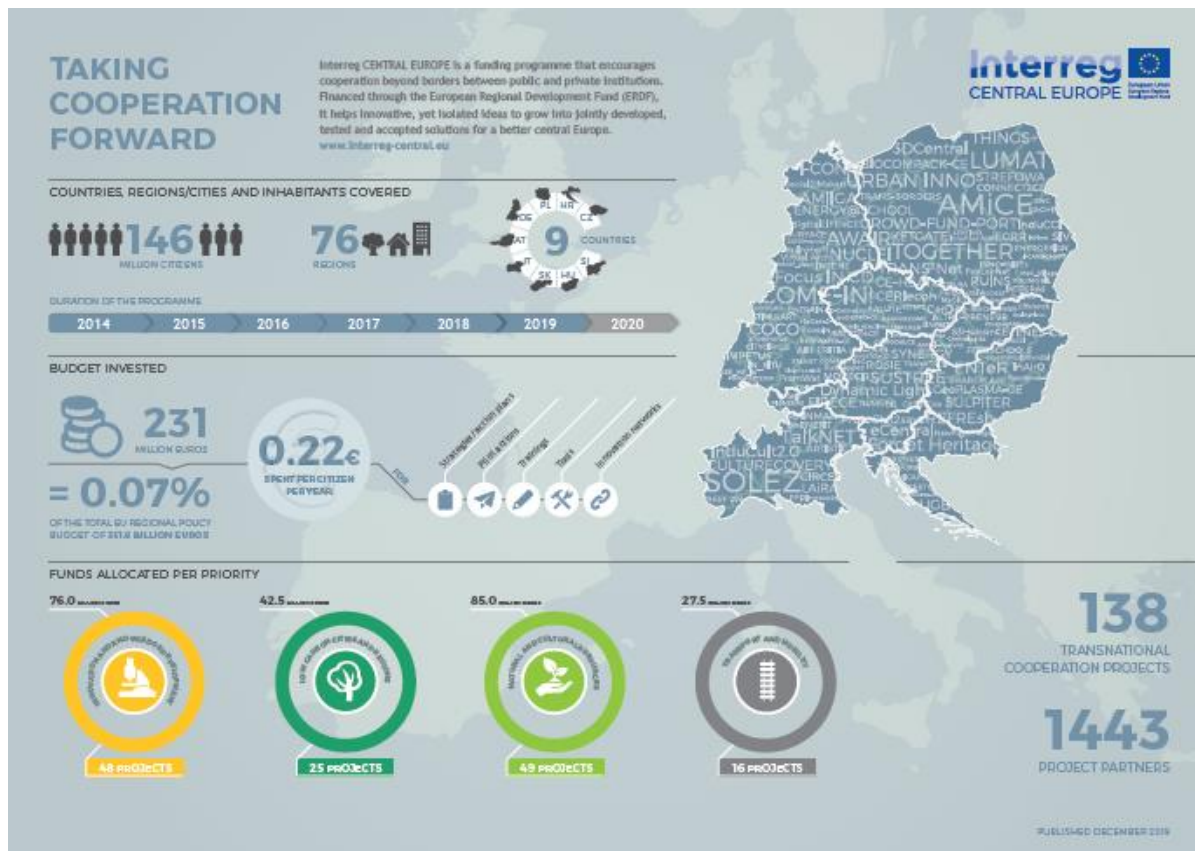

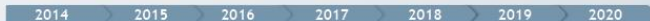

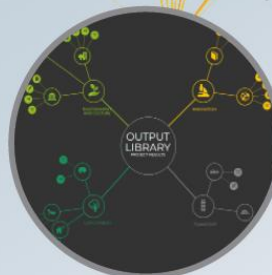

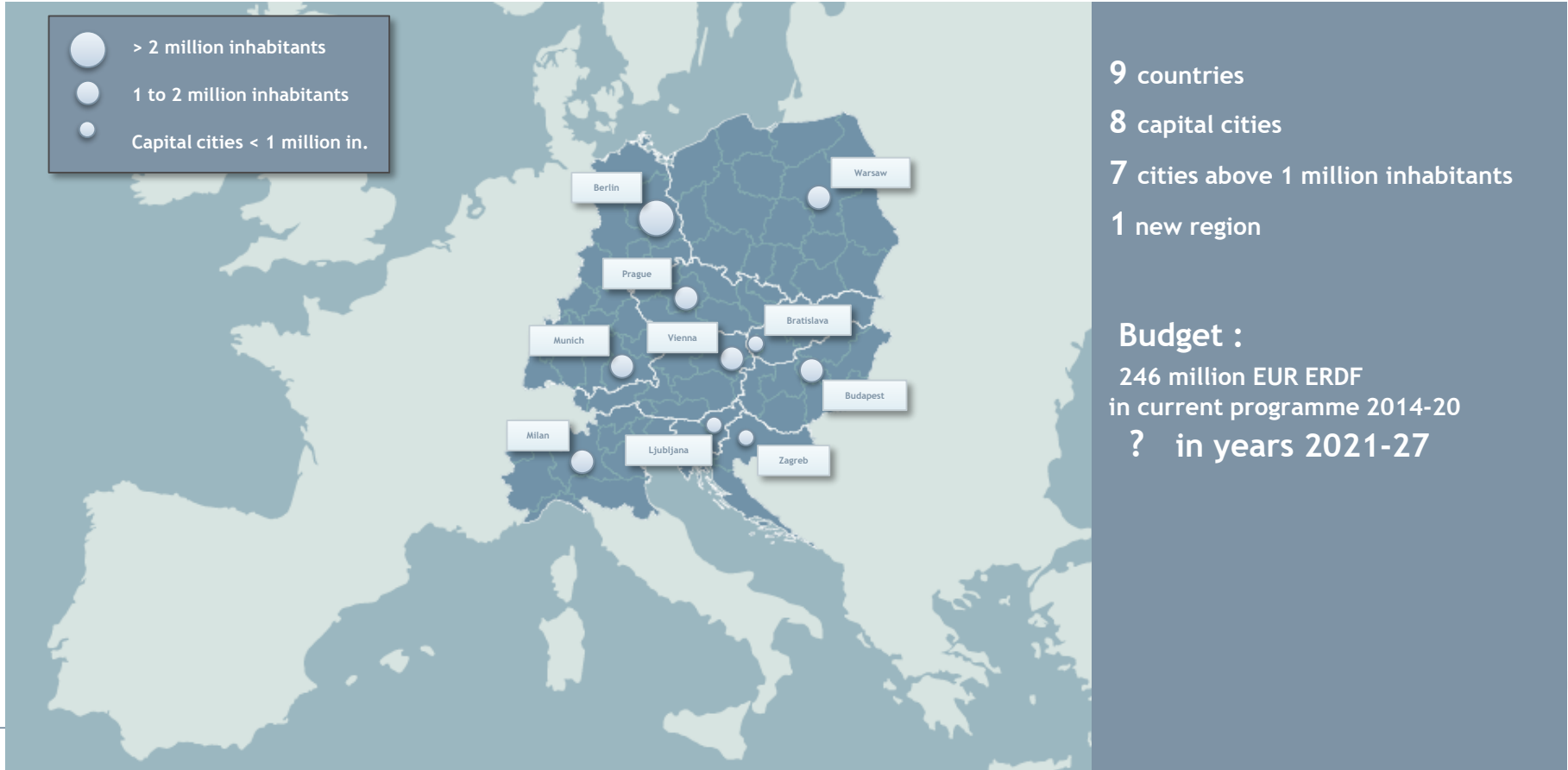

# The new Interreg CE Programme: key data

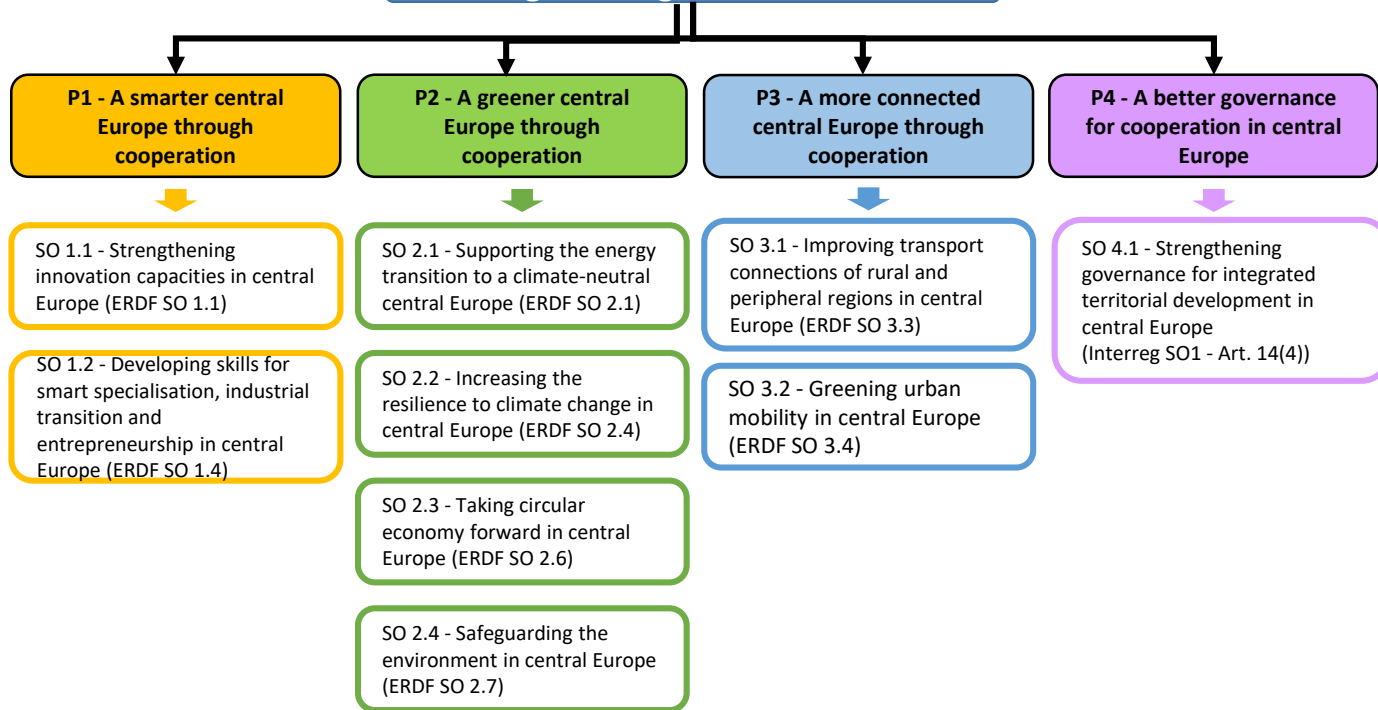


# The new Interreg CE Programme: an inclusive approach

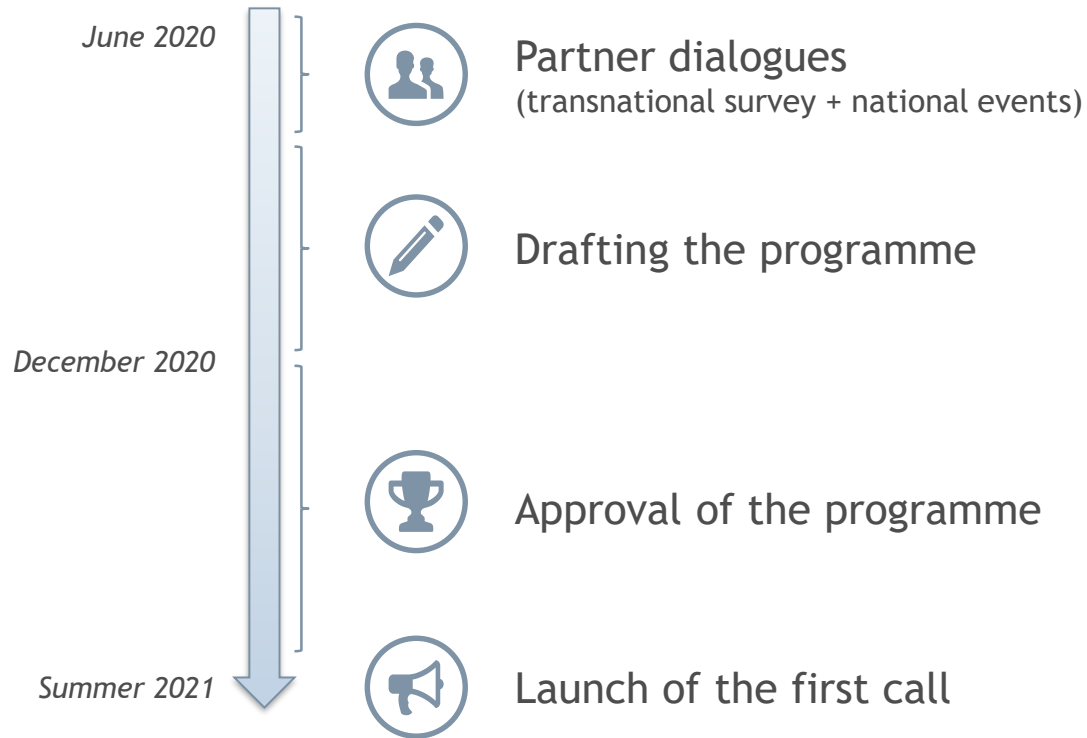


# Shaping Interreg CE 2021-27: Priority Axes
